Flint Is Family in Three Acts is a multi-part exhibition by renowned artist LaToya Ruby Frazier, which captures one of the most devastating ecological crises in U.S. history through a monumental oeuvre of photographs, video, and text. Drawing inspiration from the urgency in Frazier's work, Stamps Gallery, part of the Penny W. Stamps School of Art & Design at the University of Michigan, initiated a partnership with the Flint Institute of Arts and the MSU Broad Art Museum to bring this important exhibition together for the first time in Michigan.
